Rationale:

- 2. Provide opportunities for the staff to become more effective in EOTC.
- 3. Follow Ministry of Education regulations and guidelines on safety, supervision, risk management, leadership and legal requirement.
- 4. Using the application for EOTC excursion form (Curric/EOTC/p1/f1) provided in the Blue Policy Handbook apply to the Principal for permission to undertake class visits.
- 5. Parental/Guardian permission will be gained prior to all EOTC excursions.
