TE TIRITIO WAITANGI POLICY

(Treaty of Waitangi)

Rationale

The Te Tiriti o Waitangi is the founding document of our nation. It provides a framework for partnership today and in the future. Our School accepts its responsibilities for attempting to fulfil the intent of the Treaty.

Purpose

1. To ensure the curriculum reflects Maori perspective.
2. To make equitable provision for the needs of Maori.
3. To recognise Maori values in resourcing the school.

Guidelines

1. Curriculum planning will ensure that Maori perspectives are embodied in the content, methodology and assessment.
2. Teaching strategies will utilise Maori examples.
3. Pastoral care will be provided in culturally appropriate ways.
4. Maori values and customs will be, as far as practicable incorporated into school life.
5. Consultation with the Maori community will occur.
6. Training will be offered to Board of Trustee and Staff members in Tiriti o Waitangi
